Please note the following important information related to student finances:

- The price of tuition, room and board goes up an average of 4% each year.
- International students are required to purchase medical insurance for the entire academic year (minimum of nine months). Students must be prepared to pay for this on their own (not included on school bill) or show evidence of coverage.
- All students who are first-year students and under age 21 are required to live on campus during their first year. Please note that the university does not assist students in finding off-campus housing. If students choose to live off campus, they will be responsible for their own apartment contract.
- Fees and the cost of books vary according to the program/major and are not included in tuition costs.
- Vincennes University does not generally provide scholarships for international students. All students however are eligible to apply and compete for academic scholarships in their second year at VU.

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Payment and Wire Transfer Information

Please note that payment for all tuition, fees, room and board is due at the beginning of each semester. First time international students register for classes once they arrive and complete placement testing. After class registration, the student will be able to get their school account balance from the Financial Service Department or online through their MyVU account.

There are two options for paying your school bill:

1. Pay in full—due two weeks after schools begins.
2. Payment plan—this costs an extra \$30 for the semester. Full payment of the student account must be made by the mid-semester break (8 weeks).
